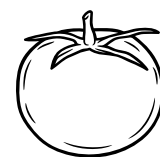
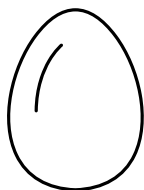
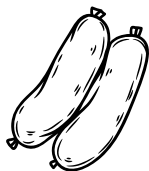
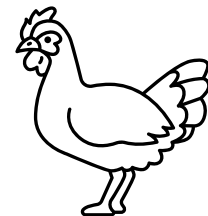
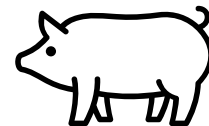
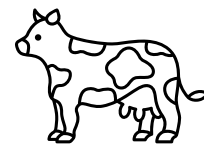




Where does our food come from?

Draw a line between the food we eat and where it comes from. The first one has been done for you. At the end, have a class discussion to see if you can name other foods that come from the same animal or plant.

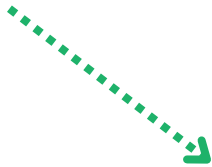

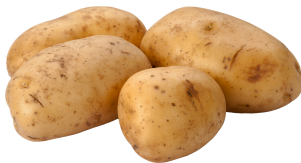


What county are my crops from?

Ireland's climate is perfect for growing oats they love cool, damp, and rainy weather! Even racehorses love Irish oats!



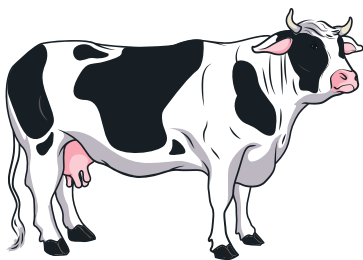
